

# WARNING

DISCONNECT POWER BRFORE RE-LAMPING OR WIRING THE FIXTURE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS COMPLETELY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION.

- 2. Attach the mounting bracket to the outlet box using the mounting screws. (See figure 2).
- 3. Thread the hex nut onto the nipple and the nipple into the crossbar. Place the canopy over the nipple and against the ceiling. Adjust the nipple so that 1/2" of threads extend beyond the canopy. Tighten the hex nut against the crossbar. Using the cap nut, install the canopy.
- 6. Adjust the cable wire and attach the cable grip lock to the canopy. Hang the fixture on the cable wire and adjust to the desired height.
- 7. Thread the lead wires and ground wire up through alternating links of the cable wire until the ceiling is reached.
- 8. Remove the fixture from the outlet box.
- 9. Measure 8" lead and ground wire beyond the top of the cable wire. Cut off the excess wire. Strip the insulation off the ends of the leads exposing approximately 1/2" wire. Twist the strands of wire together. Push the leads and ground wire into the canopy.

### WARNING

Make sure that there is no exposed wire or strands that could cause a dangerous short circuit!

- 10. Fasten the ground wire to the green or bare copper wire in the outlet box (if outlet box is plastic) or to the green screw on the crossbar.
- 11. Connect by fastening the black wire (+) coming from the fixture into the led driver where as red wire indicated (Refer to the figure 1)

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Never fasten the ground wire to the black or "hot" wire! Failure to follow this instruction could result in serious injury or death!

12. Connect by fastening the white wire (-) coming from the fixture into the led driver where as blue wire indicated. same as step 11.

## WARNING DO NOT EXCEED RECOMMENDED WATTAGE!

- 13. Install the lamps (lighting bulbs). NOTE: This fixture is rated for 60 watts candelabra base type B, BA, C or CA lamp.
- 14. Using the ball nut, loosely fasten the fixture to the mounting plate. Rotate and align the canopy as necessary .Tighten the ball nut.
- 15. Attach the center stem and place the glass column together with the stainless trim, place the end cap and screw the finial and lock bushing to hold the glass column in place (See figure-3).

#### NOTICE:

Must use a incandescent dimmer with LED's on this fixture. \*Lutron Maestro dimmer not compatible.



16. Restore power to circuit at breaker or fuse box.
