
#### 290-43 CHARM LARGE PENDANT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



## WARNING

DISCONNECT POWER BEFORE RE-LAMPING OR WIRING THE FIXTURE

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS COMPLETELY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION.



- This fixture is supplied with with a 4-pcs. stem. There is one 6" section, two 12" section and one 18" section. This feature allows the fixture to be mounted with a stem up to 48" in length in 6" increments.
- This fixtue is supplied with a swivel. By rotating the canopy the fixture may be mounted to angled ceiling.

#### **FIXTURE PREPARATION**


1. Remove the fixture, parts and parts bag(s) from the carton.

#### NOTICE:

• Before discarding the carton, double check to make certain that all parts are found.

#### **FIXTURE INSTALLATION**

 Attach the heavy duty strap to the junction box. (The green screw should face the floor) Place the heavy duty strap at the junction box and fasten using the mounting screw. (See Figure-01)



2. Determine the overall desired length of the fixture. Assemble the adjustable stems Small Hex Nut Swivel Blocker one at a time onto the fixture leads. Tape the end of the leads to a stiff wire (coat hanger) to aid in pulling them through the stems. Place the canopy onto the stem. Swivel ball Assemble the ball swivel on the stem. Canopy 3. Then attach the SAFETY CABLE to the building or structure or brace. (See figure-02 and figure-03) Connector WARNING REFER TO THE ILLUSTRATION FOR CORRECT AND SAFE INSTALLATION OF SAFETY Adjustable stem CABLE. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THIS INSTRUCTION COULD RESULT HARM/DAMAGE TO THE FIXTURE, PROPERTY AND/OR PERSON(S)! 4. Cut off the excess fixture wire 6" beyond the swivel ball on the stem. FIGURE-02 Strip  $\frac{1}{2}$ " insulation from the ends of the wire. Twist the wire strands together. STUCTURE OR BRACE 5. Fasten the ground wire to the green or bare copper wire in the outlet box or the green screw on the heavy duty strap. JUNCTION BOX CABLE CLIF 6. Fasten the white fixture lead to the white wire in the outlet box. STUD Fasten the wires together with an approved fastener (wire nut). Starting about 1" below the fastener, tightly wrap the connection with electrical tape so that the connections seals the end of the fastener. CANOPY BALL NUT SAFETY CABLE WARNING GREEN SCREW FIGURE-03 Make sure that there is no exposed wire or strands that could cause a dangerous short circuit! FIXTURE Electrical tape Approved fastener (wire nut) METAL CAP BARREL NUTS 7. Connect the black fixture lead to the black wire in the outlet box. Fasten the joined wires as in step 5. 8. Pull up & attach the canopy to the heavy duty strap and secure it with ball nuts. (See Figure-03) 9. Install the lamps. (type-A lamp) GLASS DIFFUSER NOTICE: This fixture is rated for 100w type-A lamp. WARNING DO NOT EXCEED RECOMMENDED WATTAGE! 10. Install glass diffuser to the fixture, fit the glass to the metal cap and secure it by fastening the barrel nut to the metal cap. (See Figure-04) 11. Restore power to the circuit breaker or fuse box.
